Rolled up newspaper	450 years
Plastic bags	Never
A baby's nappy	Between 10 & 20 years and will slowly break up into small pieces
Aluminium can	10 years
Glass	100 years, some parts never disappear
Plastic drinks straw	Take up to two years to rot away
