AND PARAGRAPH 1 OF SCHEDULE 14

MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. MV-748 (PART) MALVERN)
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

The above order was made on 5th June 2019. The effect of the order will be to divert that length and the whole width of public footpath no. MV748, Malvern, running from point A, Ordnance Survey "OS" grid reference SO78644 48571, on Lower Howsell Road, in a south-easterly direction for 196 metres to point B, OS grid reference SO78815 48475, to a line running from point A, OS grid reference SO78644 48571, a point on Lower Howsell Road, in a south-south-westerly direction for 9 metres on the footway to point C, grid reference SO78642 48562, then continuing on the footway in a south-easterly turning easterly direction for 36 metres to point D, grid reference SO78673 48548, then continuing on the footway in a south-easterly direction for 41 metres to point E, grid reference SO78708 48525, then continuing on the footway in a north-easterly direction for 11 metres to point F, grid reference SO78716 48530, then continuing across the road and on the footway in a south-easterly direction for 59 metres to point G, grid reference SO78764 48494, then continuing on the footway in an east-south-easterly direction for 34 metres to point H, grid reference SO78792 48488, then continuing on the footway in a south-easterly direction for 25 metres to point B, grid reference SO78815 48475, as shown on the order map.
