## Broadwas and Cotheridge Neighbourhood Plan

### Information Statement

A Referendum relating to the Broadwas and Cotheridge Neighbourhood Plan will be held on Thursday 1<sup>st</sup> August 2019.

The question that will be asked in the Referendum is “**Do you want Malvern Hills District Council to use the Broadwas and Cotheridge Neighbourhood Plan to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?**”

The Referendum area is identified on the map which is included at the end of this Information Statement. The Referendum area is the same as the area which has been designated as the Broadwas and Cotheridge Neighbourhood Area which covers the entire parishes of Broadwas and Cotheridge.

A person is entitled to vote in the Referendum if:

- He or she is entitled to vote in an election of any Councillor of Malvern Hills District Council any of whose area is in the Referendum area; and
- His or her qualifying address for the election is in the Referendum area. A person’s qualifying address is, in relation to a person registered in the register of electors, the address in respect of which he or she is entitled to be so registered.

The Referendum expenses limit that will apply in relation to the Referendum is **£2,391.97**. The number of persons entitled to vote in the Referendum by reference to which that limit has been calculated is **508**.

The Referendum will be conducted in accordance with procedures which are similar to those used at local government elections.

- A statement that sets out general information as to Town and Country Planning including Neighbourhood Planning and the Referendum;
- Map of the Broadwas and Cotheridge Neighbourhood Plan Area.
