





## Population by age group, 2015 England















































#### Life expectancy, compared to England, years, 2011-2015







## Population by age group, 2015 England



































#### Life expectancy, compared to England, years, 2011-2015









## Population by age group, 2015 England





































#### Life expectancy, compared to England, years, 2011-2015







## Population by age group, 2015 England

































#### Life expectancy, compared to England, years, 2011-2015













































#### Life expectancy, compared to England, years, 2011-2015







# Population by age group, 2015 England




























