MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. 650 (PART) CLIFTON ON TEME  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021

The above order was made on 4<sup>th</sup> November 2021. The effect of the order will be to divert that length and the whole width of public footpath no. 650, Clifton on Teme, running from point A, Ordnance Survey "OS" grid reference SO 72075 60826, the western end of footpath 650, in a north-easterly direction for 54 metres to point B, OS grid reference SO 72122 60853, then continuing in an east-north-easterly direction for 30 metres to point C, grid reference SO 72151 60859, to a line running from point D, OS grid reference SO 72072 60833, a point on the public highway, in an easterly direction for 3 metres to point E, OS grid reference SO 72075 60833, then continuing in a north-easterly direction for 68 metres to point F, grid reference SO 72133 60868, then continuing in a south-easterly direction for 20 metres to point C, a point on footpath 650, at grid reference SO 72151 60859, as shown on the order map.
