

NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF PUBLIC PATH ORDER  
TOWN AND COUNTY PLANNING ACT 1990 S.257 AND PARAGRAPH 7 of SCHEDULE 14  
MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL

MALVERN HILLS DISTRICT COUNCIL (PUBLIC FOOTPATH NO. HW-552 (PART) HALLOW)  
PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2019

On 11<sup>th</sup> June 2019 Malvern Hills District Council confirmed the above order. The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert that length and the whole width of public footpath no. HW-552, Hallow, running from point A, Ordnance Survey "OS" OS grid reference SO 82831 58434, the western end of footpath HW-552 at its junction with footpath HW-555, in an east-north- easterly direction for 78 metres to point B, OS grid reference SO 82907 58453, to a line running from point A, OS grid reference SO 82831 58434, a point on footpath 555, in a north-easterly direction for 19 metres to point C, grid reference SO 82847 58445, then continuing in a south easterly turning east-north-easterly direction on the footway for 65 metres to point B, grid reference SO 82907 58453, as shown on the order map.

A copy of the order as confirmed may be seen free of charge at The Council House, Avenue Road, Malvern, WR14 3AF between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm on Mondays to Thursdays and between 9.00am and 4.00 pm on Fridays. This order comes into force on the date on which Malvern Hills District Council certify that the terms of Article 2 of the order have been complied with, but if any person aggrieved by the order desires to question its validity or that of any provision contained in it on the ground that it is not within the powers of the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the confirmation of the Order, he or she may apply to the High Court for any of these purposes under s.287 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 within 6 weeks from the date on which notice is first published as required by paragraph 7 of Schedule 14 to the Act.
