Dear Mr Clarke,

We would like to object  
to this planning proposal behind our  
house.

At this moment in time Piper Homes are  
building 33 houses at the side of our  
house/garden, we have lived here 46 years  
and these last 10 months have been the  
worst in our lives.

The family all have many health problems  
It has been a living hell, the noise  
has been horrendous, the dust you  
could not see your hand in front of  
you for most of the day, we could  
not have your windows and doors open  
all through the summer.

Wash days we had to light our  
Rayburn cooker approx 4 times weekly to  
dry washing.

All the noise from 3 large tracked diggers  
3 large dumpers, 2 small diggers, power  
saw cutting steel have all made my  
tinnitus worse.

I was promised a 8ft high ply temporary

fence by my house before work started.

Also a panel fence the length of my fin tree hedge to protect hedge.

All this was done 2 weeks after they had stripped the top soil off.

They stripped the top soil and 2nd grade soil off the whole site and put it in massive piles by our house, the 2nd grade soil up against our hedge.

The large tracked digger could have touched my house with his digger bucket 4 metres away.

The noise was horrendous even in my house this is why I am suffering so much with my tinnitus.

Piper homes would dig out footings or dig a section of road out and tip 2nd grade soil in a mountain by my house.

This would mean 3 large dumper one after the other tipping 2nd grade soil then reversing down the mountain of soil, with

the usual Beep Beep Beep Beep Beep Beep followed by massive tracked digger levelling the mountain and thumping down the side of the pile with digger bucket.

The mountain of 2nd grade soil was over 3 metres high.

The next day they would take it away, to another area on the site, to put around newly built footings, leaving 6 inches for top soil for later on.

This is what happens everyday, bring it take it away it has been a living hell, torture 4 metres from house.

It is obvious to us if the top soil mountain had been next to our house it would have stayed there to the end of the job, and we would not have had so much horrendous noise + dust. We are very concerned about the proposed site for 40 houses at the back of our house, as we only have  $1\frac{1}{2}$  metre path between our house and the proposed building site. As a Pre Requisite could we be offered the corner triangle piece of land behind our house? Which would give as a bit of privacy and help to keep the noise away from the house, this triangle piece of land has been overgrown with thorns and bushes the last 46 years we have lived here.

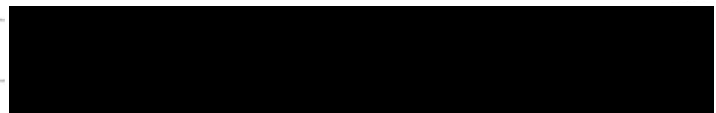
Obviously before any planning permission is granted.
