Policy LB/H/6: Housing: Site allocation

Sport England supports in principle the proposal within the housing allocation for the provision of a significant area of land within the site for sport and recreation use, including the provision of new playing field. In para 5.1.17 reference is made to the evidence set out in the Malvern Hills Playing Pitch and Outdoor Sports Assessment report, and the associated Strategy and Action (completed Dec 2021). The assessment and strategy were prepared in line with Sport England's methodology and guidance to assess the demand and supply of pitches and other outdoor sports facilities, inc accordance with para 98 of the NPPF.

Leigh and Bransford Badgers FC currently play across several sites including Ralphs Field, however there is currently a lack of security of tenure at this site which is referenced in the Playing Pitch Strategy. There is also reference to the existing ancillary facilities being poor quality. The documents reference the club's aspiration for exploring options to bring their football demand together at one site as a dedicated home facility to play and train, and so the proposed allocation of approximately 5.5ha of land for sports and recreation use may help to better address their needs.

What is unclear from the policy wording is whether the policy only requires the developer to provide the land, or whether the developer would be responsible for delivering the provision of the pitches and ancillary facilities? If the development is not required to fully fund the provision of the facilities, how will this be delivered? Will the developer be expected to contribute to the cost of these works? How will such a contribution be derived? Sport England would recommend that the policy and reasoned justification are appropriately amended to address these points, including for instance appropriate references to existing Development Plan policies for developer contributions in the South Worcester Local Plan (or any successor policies).

Sport England would advocate that the reasoned justification should make appropriate
